Highlights of the new and improved partnership include:

1. An **advance schedule of live and online courses** will be established each calendar year, allowing for better marketing and promotion of the courses.

2. LUTCF/FSS class **moderator compensation has been increased significantly**, rewarding the recruitment of larger classes. (For classes of 4-6 students, the payment remains at \$100 per class; for 7-9 students, the payment is \$350 per class; for 10-14 students, the payment moves to \$600 per class; and for 15 students or more, moderators will receive \$1,000.)

3. The American College is committed to **responding within two business days to service or support questions raised by students**, moderators or chairs, and ongoing training is being provided to Professional Education Counselors at The College about these programs.
4. **Strong revenue sharing** with the appropriate state or local associations will continue for LUTCF/FSS programs. Local or state associations will receive a revenue share of registration fees collected for all students who are clearly identified and verified as members of NAIFA taking classes led and sponsored by a NAIFA local or state.
